- Many different kinds of chemicals



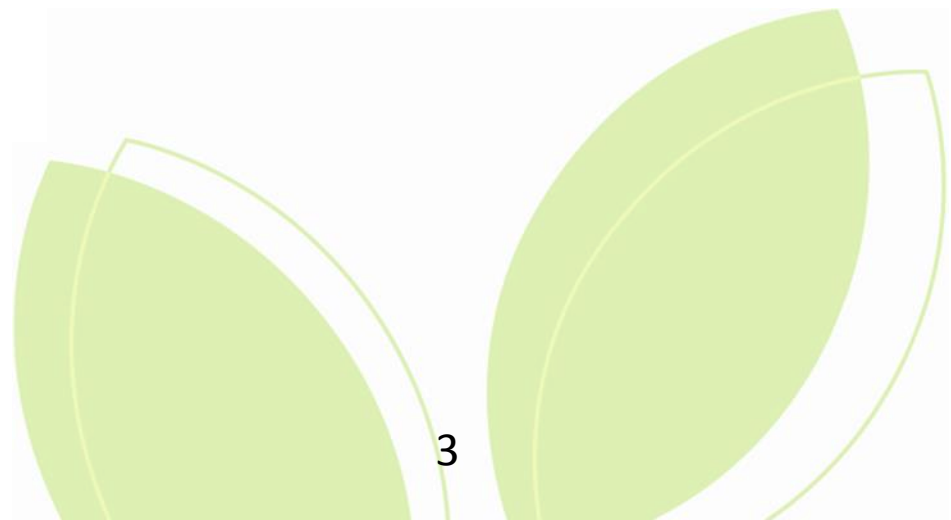
